Term: Autumn 2



GRIT

Nichols class will be working on a GRIT curriculum to build upon their resilience and team-work skills. We will be looking at topics such as growth mindset and perseverance.

The students will be thinking about things they would like to achieve and will be supported to develop the skills and knowledge they need to be able to overcome any challenges in their way of achieving those things.

They will be looking at positive friendships and the importance of teamwork in achieving your goals

PSHE/British Values

British values are embedded daily and students are rewarded for displaying them.

PE

This term Nichols class will be learning the new sport of Tchoukball. They will be learning the different rules of play and developing tactics and strategies during play.

They will also be partaking in outdoor adventurous activities at Thorpe woodland centre.

English

This term in English Nichols class will study:

Point of View writing relating to war poetry and be introduced to Shakespeare

They will explore sections of text from a selection of the following:

Much Ado About Nothing, Romeo and Juliet, Othello, The Tempest,

- Troilus and Cressida,
- The Taming of the Shrew

They will be able to: select short phrases and explain each in context. They will also be able to: demonstrate an understanding of war poetry and relate to National Days.

Science

Electricity and energy, exploring: electrical circuits, energy transfer, energy resources, heating and cooling curves.

Maths

This half term, students will be studying measure. They will be looking at length, distance, capacity and mass. They will study how the units of measurement are used. They will learn the vocabulary of metric measure. They will also look at time, including seconds, minutes, hours, days, weeks, months and years. Students will look at money and finances in context, beginning to understand budgeting.
