

Lee Class Autumn 1 2023



Acorn Park

PSHE

This term Lee will be focusing on equality- both in the UK and the workplace- and how to challenge inequality. They will be learning about the opportunities and challenges of living in a multicultural society. They will also be learning about power in relationships

PE

In practical lessons the class will be studying both football and Tchoukball. They will learn the rules of each game, different skills such as shooting, passing and defending/marking. The class will be developing these skills in preparation for the Autumn games at the end of term.

Animal Care

Lee will be working towards and Land Based qualification. They will be working on the care of animals and care of plants through theory and practical sessions. There will also be a focus on work experience and working safely in workplace.

English

Lee will be working towards their Entry Level or Level 1 Functional Skills qualifications. They will be practicing the relevant papers and honing skills in reading, writing and analysing. They will be watching a version of Athol Fugard's Tsotsi and reading excerpts of the text. They will complete work around Tsotsi in preparation for the upcoming qualifications.

Science

Year 11 students in this class will be working towards a Biology only GCSE qualification and will be exploring ecology this half term with focus or big idea on: organisms require a supply of energy and materials for which they are often dependent on or in competition with other organisms. The topics will be Adaptations, interdependence and competition, Ecosystem organisation, Biodiversity and the effect of human interaction on ecosystems, Trophic levels in an ecosystem and Food production.

Computer

Science

This term Shakespeare will gain an understanding and knowledge of how to use spreadsheets to store and manipulate data, how to use common functions, and how to extract data to create visual representations using charts. Learners will use spreadsheets to track and calculate income, make predictions, and answer “what if...?” questions.

Citizenship

This term we will be focusing on human rights. We will be looking at human rights across the global and discussion social justice around refugees.

Forest School

Lee class will participate in sessions that will link to the Autumn season. They will take part in activities such as boundary games, crafts, cooking and skills such as knots, den building and whittling.

Employability

Lee class will be focusing on interview skills. They will learn how to prepare for an interview and plan to arrive punctually. Students will consider how they would present themselves positively at an interview. Skills learnt will then be applied in mock-interviews- after which they will review and reflect on their performance.

Maths

This half term Lee will be consolidating work on Numbers including the use of decimal points, percentages, Square root numbers, BIDMAS (Brackets, Indices ,Division ,Multiplication, Addition and Subtraction) for decimals and fractions and recognising SURD(Square roots that cannot be simplified)
