PSHE

Is it possible to stay true to yourself and be in healthy relationships? We will be looking at the following. PE

Lee will be exploring target games this term. This will include games and activities such as Kurling, Boccia and Archery- in preparation for the winter games competition at the end of term. They will be developing their turn taking skills as well as their aim and accuracy.

Art

The students will produce an illustrated study of the life and work of an artist. Create a product for display. Keep a journal and create a portfolio. Curate an exhibition of artwork and visit the exhibition- interview with a local professional.

English

Lee will be preparing for their Speaking and Listening presentations this half term. They will suggest at least five different subjects and write the pros and cons for each. They will choose one of their topics and research it in depth, producing a PowerPoint and speech which will be presented to the English Department staff for their Functional Skills qualification.

Science

Year 11 students in this class will continue working towards a biology only GCSE qualification and will complete the ecology unit whose big idea is: organisms require a supply of energy and materials for which they are often dependent on or in competition with other organisms. The topics will be trophic levels in an ecosystem, biodiversity and the effect of human interaction on ecosystems, and Food production.

Computer Science

Lee will explore the language of HTML this term. This will allow them to create websites that will be structured with CSS. With this they will be able to organise information for effective delivery online.

Forest School

Lee class will participate in sessions that will link to the Autumn season. They will take part in activities such as boundary games, crafts, cooking and skills such as knots, den building and whittling.

Animal Care

Lee will be working towards and Land Based qualification. They will be working on the care of animals and care of plants through theory and practical sessions. There will also be a focus on work experience and working safely in workplace.

Citizenship

This term Lee will be consolidating their knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages. They will work with ratios using these skills through working with money and measurement. By the end they will be able to recognise and understand recurring decimals and the equivalent in fractions and percentages in real life scenarios.

Employability

Lee class will continue to focus on on interview skills. They will learn how to prepare for an interview and plan to arrive punctually. Students will consider how they would present themselves positively at an interview. They will also consider how they would find out more about places of employment. Skills learnt will then be applied in mock-interviews- after which they will review and reflect on their performance. Students will take part in careers interviews this term and use that to prioritise next steps- researching post 16 options.
