PSHE

Over the next half term, we will be covering the following topics: What 'being an adult' means to me, examples of legislation that relates to sex and relationships, examples of legislation around the possession and supply of drugs, tobacco and other substances, examples of legislation in reference to online activity and know the steps to take in an emergency situation.

PE

Lee will be exploring badminton. They will be looking at developing serving skills, different techniques of returning the shuttle and knowledge of rules and gameplay. They will be developing sport specific skills in preparation for the Spring games competition.

Art

The students will produce an illustrated study of the life and work of an artist. Keep a journal and create a portfolio. Curate an exhibition of artwork and visit the exhibition. They will also interview a local professional. They will explore the arts and traditions of Mardi Gras and Holi festival

English

Science

Year 11 students in this class will continue working towards a biology only GCSE qualification and will complete the ecology unit whose big idea is: organisms require a supply of energy and materials for which they are often dependent on or in competition with other organisms. The topics will be trophic levels in an ecosystem, biodiversity and the effect of human interaction on ecosystems, and Food production.

Computer Science

This extensive programming unit takes learners from being complete novices to having the confidence to tackle any GCSE-level programming challenge. Essential programming theory is also interleaved into the practical elements of programming to provide tangible links between required knowledge and skills.

Forest School

Lee will be looking at how weather will affect us, flora and fauna of winter, learning to cook safely on different fires. The class will learn how to make jam on the fire using berries from the Autumn.

Forest skills that the class will develop will include whittling, knot tying or shelter. They will make an item made from natural material- such as clay from the soil. The term will end with Smores or Bannock bread.

Animal Care

Lee will be working towards and Land Based qualification. They will be working on the care of animals and care of plants through theory and practical sessions. There will also be a focus on work experience and working safely in workplace.

Citizenship

This term Lee will be looking at the Legal System. Covering the following topics, responsibilities and roles of citizens in the legal system, how groups can be powerful. We will also be partaking in independent investigation that is part of obtaining the GCSE qualification. We also have a Judge visiting Friday 19 January to talk to the GCSE classes.

Employability

Lee class will continue to focus on interview skills- practising a digital Mock interview. They will also be developing a CV and focusing on post 16 applications. The class will participate in a series of virtual work experiences and desk tasks- to develop

Maths

As a class they will be completing work on all aspects of Geometry. In that they will understand how to calculate angles, Lines of symmetry, and to interpret plans and nets shapes. They will be re-examining angles and how to calculate them. They will also be familiarizing themselves with their functional skills papers in preparation for their exams.
