The children will have a range of activities throughout the weeks, ranging from display designs for the next year 11s to look at, board games and in class escape room style puzzles! The aim is to relax and enjoy maths as part of our daily lives, taking the focus away from the academic application of using math skills purely for exams.</p>

PE

Shakespeare class will be taking part in Athletics this term. They will be developing the skills of running, jumping, throwing, relays and teamwork. In Running, they will be developing the ability to maintain a steady and appropriate pace during short to medium length runs. They will begin to understand how to begin a sprint from a crouched position. In Jumping they will be able to perform a basic standing long jump, focusing on swinging arms and bending knees to gain momentum. They will also begin to use appropriate arm action to maximise height. In Throwing they will be developing and mastering the skills to demonstrate a controlled underarm throw and overarm throw. They will be developing the understanding of the correct technique used in discus and shotput. In Relays and Teamwork, they will begin to understand the principles of relay races, including how to pass a baton smoothly and safely between team members. They will be able to show good teamwork during group activities, understanding the importance of supporting and encouraging others. Later in the term, they will be developing the understanding of how to play ultimate frisbee.
