They will investigate and compare different villages in northern Italy and will learn what a town in northern Italy is like. They will also describe Venice and explain how it is affected by tourism. They will then use all that they have learnt to compare northern Italy with the region of the UK where I live.</p>
<p><b><u>History</u></b></p> <p>Durrell will be studying the Sutton Hoo Project.
